## MultiPage Site Page Template:

The purposes of these pages are to provide a format and basic layout for mapping out sites pages for HCAC. It is meant to build off and work with the <u>previous training</u> about site pages such as those provided at the June 2024 convening. They are crafted in a way to help you consider the different elements that make up a page and give you a format to layout out those elements. This layout is meant to be flexible. For example, there are three areas provide for inputting media/or other embedded features, but you do not have to use all the provided blocks. The following information and the <u>instructional guide</u> will assist you in using this template.

## **Breakdown by Block Input Guidelines:**

- o Title Use title case capitalization.
- Headings/Sub Headings Headings are optional, you may use them if it makes sense for your content. For example, if you are writing a mini biography, you might include headings such as Early Life or Legacy.
- o Introductory Paragraphs The introductory paragraphs are optional and can be used to provide a brief introduction to the main topic.
- Media Blocks: There are multiple ways to represent media on Omeka S. <u>See this</u>
   resource for some of the options and some thoughts on representing different types of
   content. Choose the appropriate media block for your content.
- O Body Text, Point ## & Media Blocks These spaces hold all of the text pertaining to one subtopics or point. Each of the Body text is associated with media blocks. You do not have to use all of the media spaces. You may use one of the alternative formats at the bottom on the page in any the open spaces by copying and pasting those sections of the table into the desired spaces. Feel to delete any empty spaces.
- Credits Input the name and the affiliation of any members of your team that helped to create the page, you may add additional spaces.
- o Further Readings- There should be no more than three reference included in this page, please use the MLA citation format for citing outside sources.
- o Optional connectivity feature (browse preview, list of pages/sites)
  - O Think of this optional block as an additional way to guide readers through your content. They have landed on this page, have looked through it. Where could they go next, use these features to give them some options?
